HAS CAPITALISM FAILED?

- In trouble: USA, Eurozone
- Not in trouble: Scandinavian countries
 - High tax regime with efficient social support
 - Easy access to information
 - High intolerance of corruption
 - Inclusive government (democratic space)
 - Trusted institutions

Corruption: abuse of entrusted power for personal gain

STATE CAPTURE

- **Businesses, politicians (& civil servants) in collaboration.**
- **To shape and manipulate laws, policies, regulations and administrative processes to their own (political supporters, relatives and proxies) benefit.**

Proverbs 17:23

²³ The wicked accepts a bribe in secret to pervert the ways of justice.

Corruption Undermines Economic Development

- Market distortion – leading to less than optimum outcome
- Creates a underground economy (illegal & undesirable sectors)
- Undermines or destroy institutional capacity (independence, professionalism)
- Increase investment risks (uncertainty)
- Obstruct sound economic reforms
- Depletion of national wealth
- Distrust by the civil society

Consequences

- Increase cost of living (doing business) – inflation
- Funneling of scarce public resources to uneconomic high profile project of questionable economic value
- Conversion of public wealth to private personal property
- Increase illicit flow of fund out of the country
- Imbalance economic development (marginalizing the poor)
- Weakening work ethics & professionalism (create apathy)
- Hindrance to health & competitive market structure (inefficient monopolies)

INTEGRITY

- ❑ **Steadfast commitment in righteousness regards of circumstances**
 - **When there is no one watching**
 - **Even at a personal cost**
- ❑ **Characteristics:**
 - **Not corrupt**
 - **Uphold social justice (fair & equitable)**
 - **Truthful**
 - **Consistency, without fear or favour,**
 - **No double standards. Walk the talk**
 - **Accountable (compliance to boundaries)**

Some Cases

- GlaxoSmithKline fined US\$3 bil in US
- Alstom fined RM 133 million by Swiss Court for bribery. MACC tells MRT Corp to reject Alstom bid
- Alcatel-Lucent paid \$137 million fine in lieu bribe probes
- Siemens fined Euro 1.3 bill (RM 6 billion)
- Ex-Sime Darby senior GM gets 27 years for corruption. Fined RM 900K
